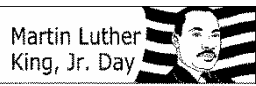

2015/2016 School Year

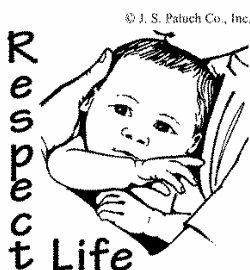
If you are a parishioner of St. Michael Church interested in enrolling your child(ren) at St. Michael School for the 2015/2016 school year, please use your parish envelopes on a regular basis to qualify for parish tuition assistance. St. Michael parishioners who use their envelopes receive a parish grant and pay \$2,500 for the first child. The amount given is not important; envelope use demonstrates your commitment to bringing your children up as good Catholics.

Facilities Use Guidelines

St. Michael School and Gym may be reserved by parish groups for parish functions only. **No private parties or receptions may be scheduled.**

Third party groups may reserve the facilities after careful review of each request by the administration. Third party users **must** complete appropriate insurance paperwork and/or show proof of appropriate insurance, pay the insurance fee and a usage fee of \$500.00.

All use of the school building **must** be scheduled through the school office (323-2162), which is open Monday-Friday, 8:00am-3:30pm, except on school holidays. Obtaining a key to the cafeteria or gym is the responsibility of the person who schedules the event. The contact person is required to be on site for the entire event, including setup and cleanup.
